Joining the autobahn, we arrive at the famous city of Cologne, where you can marvel at Europe's largest Gothic twin spire cathedral. In the afternoon, we proceed to the Vatican City, where we will visit St. Peter's Basilica and Square, a Renaissance masterpiece. 


