DAY 1 TOKYO

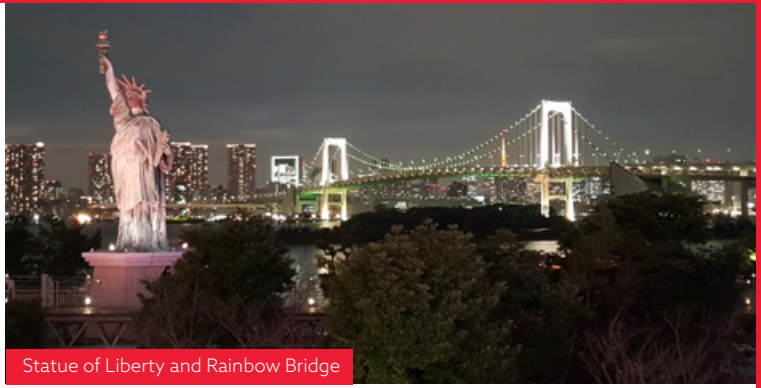

DAY 2 TOKYO

Meet our local guide and explore Tokyo, the capital of Japan and also the largest city in the world. Tokyo consists of multiple Central Business Districts (CBD). Visit the Metropolitan Government Building Observatory in the heart of the Shinjuku district. Enjoy breath taking views of Tokyo and on a clear day, you may just get a glimpse of Mount Fuji.


Travel to the Asakusa district where we visit the Sensoji temple. We will also have our first encounter with street shopping at the famous Nakamise street market. Enjoy a river Cruise. Stop for a photograph at the statue of Liberty and Views of the Rainbow bridge. Visit the Museum of Health and Medicine (Subject to availability).

In case the Museum of Health and Science is closed or unavailable we will visit the Miraikan National Museum of Emerging Science and Innovation.

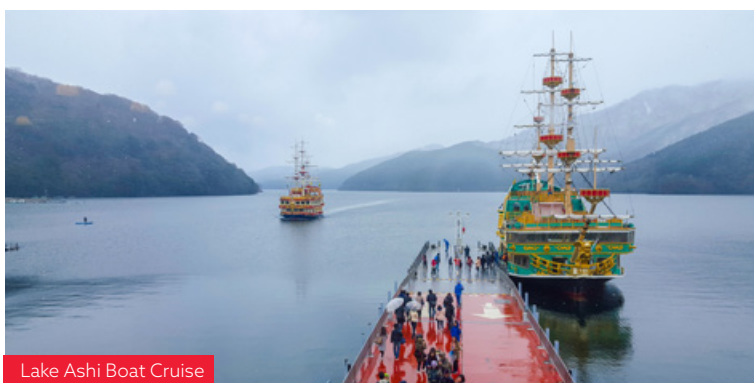
DAY 3 TOKYO - MT.FUJI - HAKONE - OSAKA

Check out from our hotel and drive towards Mount Fuji. We will visit the 5th station, the highest point accessible by vehicles. Depart for Oshino Hakkai, a small village in a scenic setting with 8 ponds, views of Mount Fuji (weather permitting) and vendors of food and souvenirs. Enjoy a boat cruise on Lake Ashi. Later we take a ride on the world famous Bullet train to Osaka. Capable of reaching a maximum speed of 320kms per hour, the bullet train offers riders an exceptionally unique and efficient travel experience. On arrival we enjoy a sumptuous dinner and then check in to our Hotel.

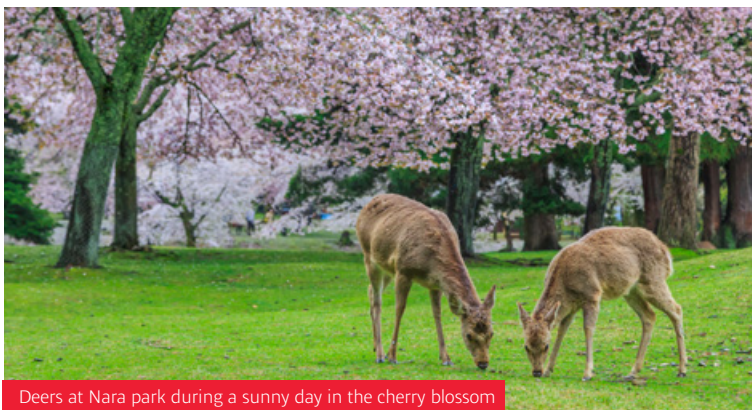

DAY 4 OSAKA - NARA - KYOTO - OSAKA

Visit the world famous Nara Deer Park, home to hundreds of freely roaming deer and also the Todaiji Temple. Constructed in 752 it houses one of Japan's largest bronze statues of Buddha. Proceed to Kyoto and take a photograph from the gardens of Kinkakuji (Golden Pavillion). Next it's on to Osaka and a visit to the gardens of the Osaka Castle.

DAY 5 OSAKA - HIROSHIMA - OSAKA

Board the Bullet train to Hiroshima. On arrival, we visit the Bomb Dome, remains of the only building still standing after the A-bomb. Stroll through the Peace Memorial Park and visit the Museum. The Cenotaph with its arch is a memorial monument to the A-bomb victims. Proceed to Hiroshima station and board the bullet train to Osaka. Spend free time in Dotonbori.
